## Event ove<u>rview</u>




Parking entry via Oaklands Road

There is free parking available at each of the playing venues for buses and cars throughout the day. As all venues are community facilities, parking spaces are unreserved and not guaranteed. All venues have disability car parking bays close to main entry for accessibility.



## **Competition details**

#### Who can participate?

The event is open to all school teams registered on the state list of registered schools. The competition allows entries into Mixed and Girls divisions, with divisions based on school year levels from years three to six. Mixed divisions allow for teams with players of any gender. Teams can have between 4-6 players per team.

On pre-liminary dates, teams that finish first in their division will receive gold medals. Teams that finish in the top 2 of the division will be offered a spot on the finals date. If those teams are unavailable, then the next placed team will be offered a spot.

#### **Competition format**

Teams compete pool play within their divisions to establish rankings based on wins, losses, & point ratio.

Schools will also be required to provide **team lists** with member numbers prior to their chosen date. Team lists can be submitted **here**.

## **Nominations**

### Eligibility

- All students must be currently enrolled at their nominated school and be the correct age to participate within their nominated division.
- Participants are **required** to have at least the \$25 Social Membership for insurance requirements. Other paid memberships are also be accepted. Join as a VSA member <a href="here">here</a>.

#### Fees & charges

- Invoices will be sent to schools after nominations close and must be paid prior to participation. Entry fees for the tournament are \$74.18 per team (including GST).
- An additional cost of \$74.18 per team will be incurred for teams who qualify for finals.
- Late nominations will only be accepted at the discretion of Volleyball South Australia and will incur a late fee of \$22 including GST.
- Penalties apply for late withdrawals. See 'key dates' for more information.

## **Player registration**

All students must be current registered members of Volleyball South Australia. It is the school's responsibility to make sure each student is registered.

Registrations can be completed online <u>here</u>. Memberships are required to ensure all participants are covered under Volleyball South Australia insurance, policies and procedures, including our code of conduct and the national integrity framework. Any students who are not registered will not be able to play, and the team they are playing in may be expelled from the competition.
